

SKYDIVE INFORMATION

BY REGISTERING FOR SKYDIVE FOR CLATTERBRIDGE YOU ARE AGREEING TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. To participate you must raise a **MINIMUM SPONSORSHIP OF £400**. At least £300 of your sponsorship must be with the charity no later than one week prior to your skydive date. If handed in any later you run the risk of being unable to complete your jump.
2. To register, simply speak to The Clatterbridge Cancer Charity Events Team and they will instruct you from there! A £50 payment is required to secure your place.
3. Should the weather be unsuitable for jumping on the day, or you have cancelled due to illness or injury with a valid doctor's note, transferring to a new jump date will come at no extra cost - the airfield will request that this new date is within the same calendar year where possible.
4. All booking deposits are non-refundable but transfers are possible.
5. A £50 re-booking fee will be charged for **TRANSFERRING JUMP DATES** that have no medical reason associated to it. This is payable to the airfield and is in addition to the original booking deposit. This should not be taken from any sponsorship money raised for The Clatterbridge Cancer Charity.
5. All cancellations and transfers must be made 4 weeks before the date of the jump.

Medical Restrictions

You must be at least 16 years old and weigh under 15 stone for men and 13 stone for ladies with your weight in proportion to your height. If you are above the weight you may still be able to jump but this will come at an additional cost. The airfield may arrange a fitness test to ensure you are able to lift your legs when you are in the harness if there are any doubts. Please call the Black Knights Parachute Centre on 01524 791 820 if this applies to you.

The principal medical restrictions for the tandem skydive are diabetes, epilepsy, fits, recurring blackouts, heart or lung disease, mental illness and some cases of asthma but if you are in any doubt please contact us for further details. You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part – this can be found at [THIS LINK](#) and is to be completed during online check-in (or printed and taken with you). **Please review it upon receiving this to check you are ok to take part. Those under the age of 18 will need the medical form signed by a parent or guardian. Those with a medical condition, will need to have a second form signed by their doctor.** This form can be found at [THIS LINK](#). This should be printed, signed and presented to the Black Knights Parachute Centre prior to the jump—failure to do so will result in no jump.

Insurance

On payment to the parachute centre of the fee for the training and jump, all jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy up to £2 million for liability to Third Parties. Please note this does not cover you or your dependents for personal injury including death. You are therefore strongly recommended to take out your own insurance cover for personal accidents benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate. You can do this either in conjunction with your own insurance broker or we can provide you with a parachuting Personal Insurance Form. If in any doubt you should seek independent advice.
